ADMISSION TICKETS AND CAR PASSES

Produce, Handicraft and Horticultural Sections: Drop off Point at Horticultural Tent on show day only. One Complimentary Admission ticket will be sent to adult exhibitors making entries totalling £6 or more. Additional discounted admission tickets may be purchased from the Entries Secretary - £8 Adults Car Passes: will be issued on request to exhibitors who need to take their car onto the Show Field to unload/load their exhibits.
